Instructional Teacher Aides

Requirements:

Each local educational agency receiving assistance shall ensure that all paraprofessionals hired after the date of enactment of the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 and working in a program supported with funds under this part shall have –

“(A) completed at least 2 years of study at an institution of higher education;

“(B) obtained an associate’s (or higher) degree; or

“(C) met a rigorous standard of quality and can demonstrate, through a formal State or local academic assessment – “(i) knowledge of, and the ability to assist in instructing, reading, writing, and mathematics; or “(ii) knowledge of, and the ability to assist in instructing, reading readiness, writing readiness, and mathematics readiness, as appropriate.

Teacher Requirements:

As a parent of a student you have the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teacher that provide instruction to your child and Federal law requires each school to provide you this information in a timely manner upon request. Specifically, you have the right to request the following information about each of your child's classroom teacher:

- Whether the teacher meets the state qualifications and licensing criteria for the grades and subjects he or she teaches.
- Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or provisional status because of special circumstances.
- The teacher's college major, whether the teachers has any advanced degrees, and the field of discipline of the certification or degree, and
- Whether paraprofessionals provide services to your child and, if so, their qualifications
