



San Elizario ISD administration in compliance with House Bill 5 requirements will ensure graduation of all students as both career and college ready by continuing to require a 4x4 curriculum for all students graduating under an approved SEISD Endorsement Plan. It has been decided that SEISD Endorsements will be Distinguished Achievement Endorsements by default.

Note: Under House Bill 5, top 10% students do NOT fall under the automatic admission program for Texas Colleges if they do not graduate with an endorsement and meet criteria for Distinguished Graduation including successful completion of Algebra II.
