The San Elizario ISD Migrant Education Program (MEP) is a federally funded program designed to meet the unique needs of children of migratory agricultural workers by providing both supplemental educational and support services.



What is an agricultural position?

Temporary and seasonal positions may include:

- Any harvesting, picking, cutting, planting ... in a field
- Nurseries-trucking/hauling of produce (fruits and vegetables)
- Dairies
- Animal Farms

Who is eligible for the Migrant Education Program?

- Any family member who has worked, intended to work or is presently working in a seasonal or temporary agricultural position.
- Any family that has moved into the San Elizario area from a different country, city, state, or country within the last three years.
- Children between the ages of 3 and 21 years of age.
